"I had no gloves, no shoes and no ring. I used to practice with a punching bag hung from a tree near a pond in my village. I am indebted to my father's friend, basic coach and mentor Sahab Singh Narwal, who adopted me after my father's demise," said Manju, who now eyes an Olympic gold.

Chandigarh: Randeep Singh Surjewala, AICC chief spokesperson, on Tuesday demanded withdrawal of the government order freezing dearness allowance (DA) and dearness relief till July 2021.
